

## EVENTS DETAILS

1. **Hospitality Room:** located at the Home House (LeVonne & Wendell's residence) located at 102 Longleaf Drive, West End, North Carolina 27376l, it will be open and available for several reunion events, as described hereunder.
2. **Open Activities:** denotes the times that there are no formal family reunion events scheduled and family members are open to participate in any activities, attractions and/or entertainment they like. Refer to the Things To Do page of the website for ideas and suggestions.
3. **Registration:** is the time the reunion committee and family officers traditionally welcome family members to the reunion; while doing late registration updates, passing out information, collecting late funds, providing reunion updates, answering questions and assisting in solving problems.
4. **Memorial Service:** is the time spent memorializing those family members who have left us since the last reunion. The service is open for any family members to provide remembrances and prayers for any departed family members.
5. **Fish Fry Cookout:** a small cookout style meal, featuring a fish fry, with beverages is provided on Friday evening as part of the welcoming program.
6. **Card Tournament:** the annual card tournament, where participants pay small entry fees, awards are given and the proceeds support the scholarship fund. Under Activities, read the Card Tournament overview and sign up for the tournament to be eligible for awards.
7. **Talent Showcase Program:** the second annual Talent Showcase program is a restart of the personal/individual talents shows we had for many of the earliest reunions. Family performances volunteer to show their skills. Under Activities, read the Talent Showcase Program overview and sign up for the performances.
8. **Golf Outing:** what has now become an annual reunion event, family members will play at the Seven Lakes Golf Course. Under Activities, read the Golf Outing overview and sign up for the outing.
9. **Family Meeting:** everyone is invited to attend the traditional Family Business Meeting, where previous minutes are presented, committee and family officer reports are provided, information is distributed, discussions conducted, and new family policies, practices, and procedures are voted on.
10. **Cookout:** will be a buffet style cookout type dinner (bar-b-que, ribs, chicken, potato salad, etc, etc), including salads, appetizers, desserts, soft drinks and beverages.
11. **Card Tournament Awards:** to be conducted immediately following the conclusion of the card tournament, where awards will be presented to winners.
12. **Open Discussions:** discussions on at least the following topics will be conducted 1) Remember November, 2) Remembering the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, and 3) Knowing Our Roots.
